

## **Instructions**

Enclosed are two photo frames:

- One for a 4" x 6" photo, portrait style
- One for a 4" x 6" photo, landscape style

Cut the outer contour of the frame along the dotted line. Ask Mommy or Daddy to cut out, with an X-acto knife, the area in the front of the frame that is marked with an X as well as the grey triangle at the back of the frame that is outlined with three dotted lines. Fold along the solid line in the centre of the frame. Insert the photo inside the frame and tape it in place. Glue the front and back together.

Fold out the triangle in the back to create a support for the frame. Bend the rectangular band at the bottom of the frame against the triangle.





Place a short strip of adhesive tape on each side of the triangle and stick it in place on the rectangular base. You now have a nice Rascally Raccoon frame.
